

Lessons learned from Drug/Drug and Drug Device

- Range of delivery modes preferable
- Range of dose schedules preferable
- Storage requirements for harsh conditions; small is better
- Packaging: discreet and easy to dispose
- Reversible (especially for young audiences)
- Information and counseling needs—myths and misconceptions can have a positive or negative impact on use/acceptability
- Easy access—available where target audiences gather; no stock outs of supply
